Basketball at Wycliffe continues to grow and develop into a full pathway. Pupils at the Prep School as early as reception are being introduced and learning about the game, whilst at the Senior School, more skill development and competitive game play is accessible. When the Sports Hall is available, pupils enjoy playing Basketball during their free time in between lessons, during lunch, in the evenings and on the weekends.

Recreational sessions are offered to pupils at Wycliffe, to enjoy a new sport and learn new skills. In the recent years numbers for basketball have always been at a max capacity, now we are able to offer more sessions to those interested.

Sessions are an opportunity for pupils to try a new sport whilst learning basic skills and fundamentals.

Pupils who wish to develop their skills further, participate in weekly team training with hopes of being selected to represent the College in school fixtures.

Prep School

In reception, pupils can learn about the sport in a fun coaching environment.

Year 5 through to 8 train weekly, learning and building the fundamentals of the sport whilst also having the opportunity to compete in the annual District Tournament.

Senior School

The senior school offers a structured basketball program for players of all abilities, recreational and elite performance.

Recreational sessions are offered weekly after school as part of pupils Games Option. Players also have the opportunity to compete in 3v3 and 5v5 House Competitions.

Players are assessed and evaluated by our Head Coach and will be placed on a development structured weekly plan, consisting of:

- Weekly competitive team trainings
- Small group and 1 to 1 sessions
- Strength & Conditioning program
- Video analysis
